### Hotel cancellation policy

If you can't join us for the convention, please adjust your arrangements as soon as you can! Remember, although it's too late to get a refund on your convention registration, you can transfer it to someone else. Hotel reservations are separate from your WCNA registration and need to be handled separately. Go to the convention page (<a href="www.na.org/wcna">www.na.org/wcna</a>), click the link in the Hotels section, and select "Manage existing reservation" when you get to the hotel portal. There is a \$75 cancellation fee for any hotel room cancellation until 26 August. The charge will appear on your credit card as CONFDIRECT\*38NA-WCNA. Cancellations must be made at least three days (72 hours) before your arrival date, or you will be charged one night's room and tax; if there's any change to your length of stay, please notify the hotel by check-in.
