CAR Survey Ideas

Since 2016, the results of a "CAR survey" have helped the World Service Conference set priorities for recovery literature, service material, and Issue Discussion Topics. Any member, group, or service body can submit ideas for the CAR survey, but that fact has not been well known. To make it easier and hopefully raise awareness, we have created a form for 2026 CAR Survey ideas. It's posted at the top of <u>the conference</u> <u>page</u>. Right below it, we've posted the results from the 2023 CAR survey, so you can see what's been included in the survey in the past. If you'd like to see one of the ideas from 2023 included again in 2026, go ahead and resubmit it.

Any member or service body can forward ideas for consideration for new or revised recovery literature, service material, or Issue Discussion Topics. Use <u>this</u> <u>link</u> to add your idea for possible inclusion in the 2026 *CAR* survey. The deadline for this input is 20 May.

Once we have a list of ideas from members, groups, service bodies, and conference participants, the World Board will combine, sort, and send them to conference participants. Ultimately, conference participants—your regional and zonal delegates and board members—will determine which items will appear on the 2026 *CAR* Survey. When the *CAR* Survey is too long, many members have shared that it becomes

overwhelming, and so it's likely not every idea submitted will wind up in the final draft survey, but don't let that hold you back from submitting.

Please only include one idea per submission.

WCNA Survey

If you haven't responded to <u>the WCNA survey</u> yet, this week is your last chance. We'll be pulling the survey down Monday 24 March. As a reminder, the 2023 World Service Conference suspended the World Convention rotation policy after 2024 "to determine what is practical and possible moving forward." The last World Convention was wonderful, but it did not meet attendance projections. The survey asks members to share why they choose to attend or not attend a World Convention.

We are not sure where or when the next World Convention will be held, but information from the survey will help the World Board make a recommendation to conference participants. To keep up to date on WCNA decisions, consider a (free) subscription to <u>NAWS News</u>.
