



Here are a few of the highlights.



There were 139 voting members participating at WSC 2023:

• 126 delegates (120 RDs, 6 ZDs)

• 13 World Board members

First truly hybrid WSC! The virtual participants who joined the conference were:

- 11 RDs
- 2 ZDs
- 1 World Board member
- 25 alternates



For the first time in NA history, the majority of delegates to the World Service Conference are from outside the USA!

134 regions and zones are now seated at the WSC.

66 of them are from the US, and 68 of them are from other places around the world.



WSC 2023 made the decision to seat five regions:

- Brazil Central
- Iran Region #1
- Nordeste Brazil
- Rio Grande do Sul
- Thailand

Interim WSC meeting

was held 28 February & 1 March 2025 for two 2-hour sessions each day

There were 144 voting members:

- 129 delegates (123 RDs, 6 ZDs)
- 15 World Board members

There were also:

- 89 alternate delegates
- 4 HRP members
- 2 cofacilitators
- 8 translators
- 15 enlisted volunteers, mostly former world level trusted servants (to facilitate and take notes for the breakout rooms)



/ 100s of members listened to the livestream in English, Portuguese, Spanish, and Russian.

Narcotics Anonymous has universal recognition and respect as a viable program of recovery.


Honesty, trust, and goodwill are the foundation of our service efforts, all of which rely upon the guidance of a loving Higher Power.



Financia Impact of the Pandemic


- NAWS income 90% from literature sales pre-pandemic
- March 2020—literature income decreased approx. 85%
- Expenses cut: staff, periodicals, travel....
- Shutdowns were five years ago and we are still building back

Member contributions continue to support our services at every level, and direct member contributions to NAWS have allowed us to increase direct support of developing NA communities.









Virtual Meetings and the NA Service System—February 2022

The role of virtual meetings in the NA service system is outside the scope of this piece but is an ongoing discussion topic in the Fellowship. When asked about virtual groups in an online survey in March, 2021, 32% of the NA members that replied self that they believed that virtual meetings can meet the criteria to be NA groups.

Based on Followship input, the World Baard plane to offer a motion to be considered at the 2023 World Service Conference. In the meantime, the board encourages local service bodies to continue to recepnize and embrace virtual meetings.

Virtual groups will be a topic of discussion at the World Service Conference in 2023 and it is premied to ofter a motion that formalizes their status within NA at that time.




