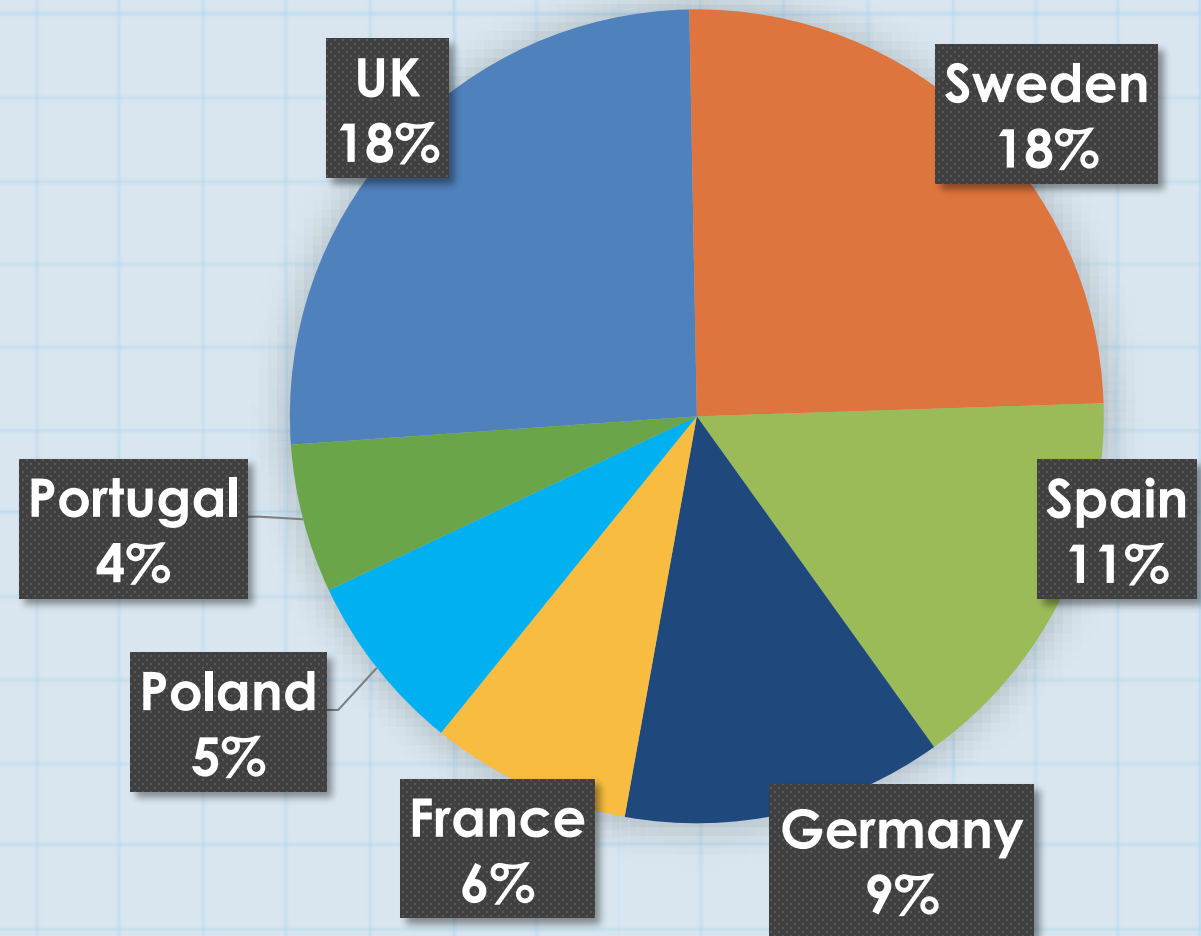

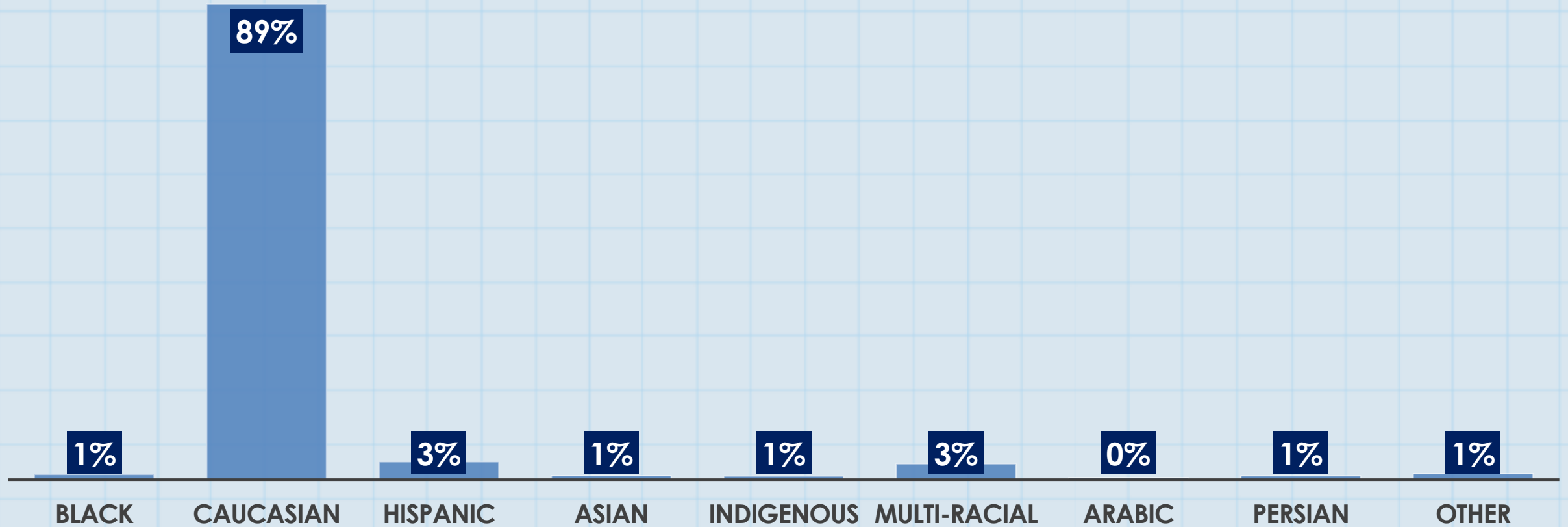
Top 7 European Countries responses

Portugal increased 4%.



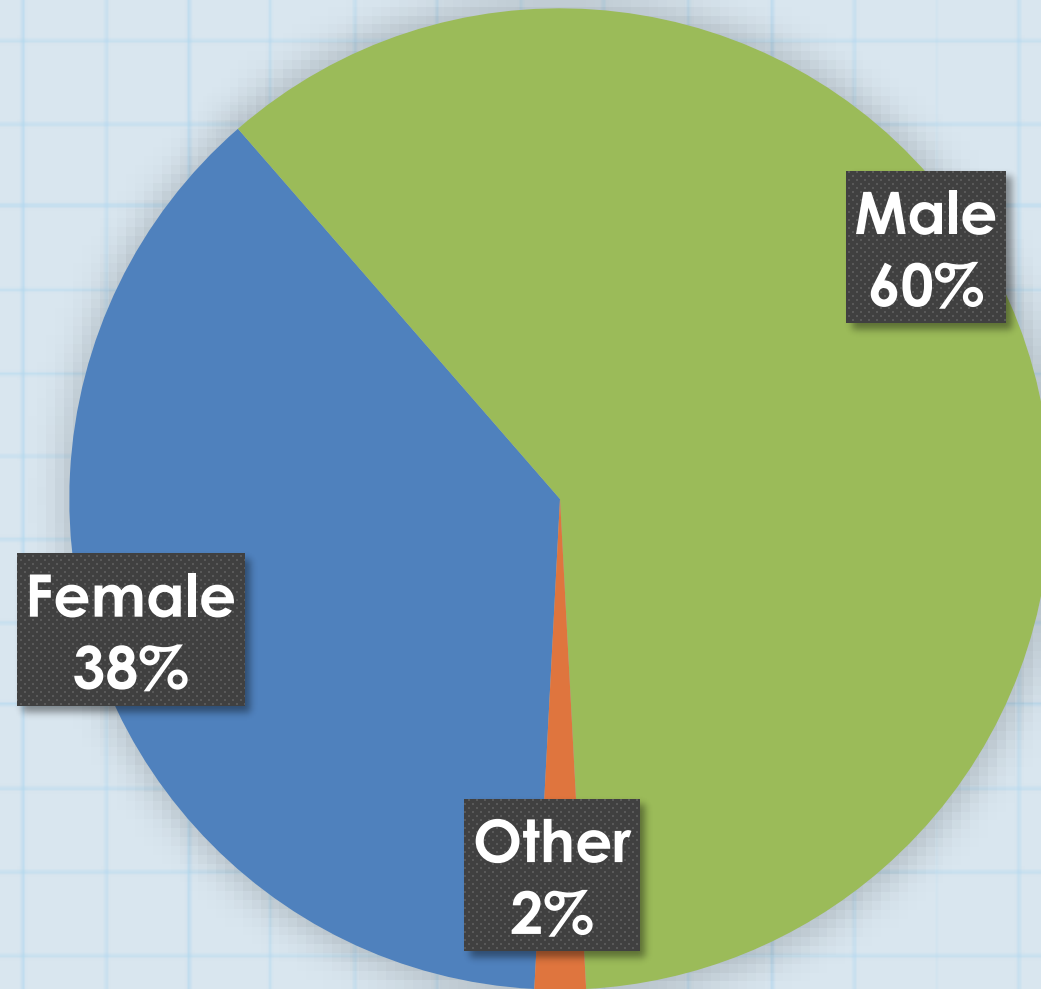
Throughout this presentation, comparisons to 2018 are percentages based on total respondents, not actual totals from year to year.

Hispanic increased 2% and Other decreased by 3%.

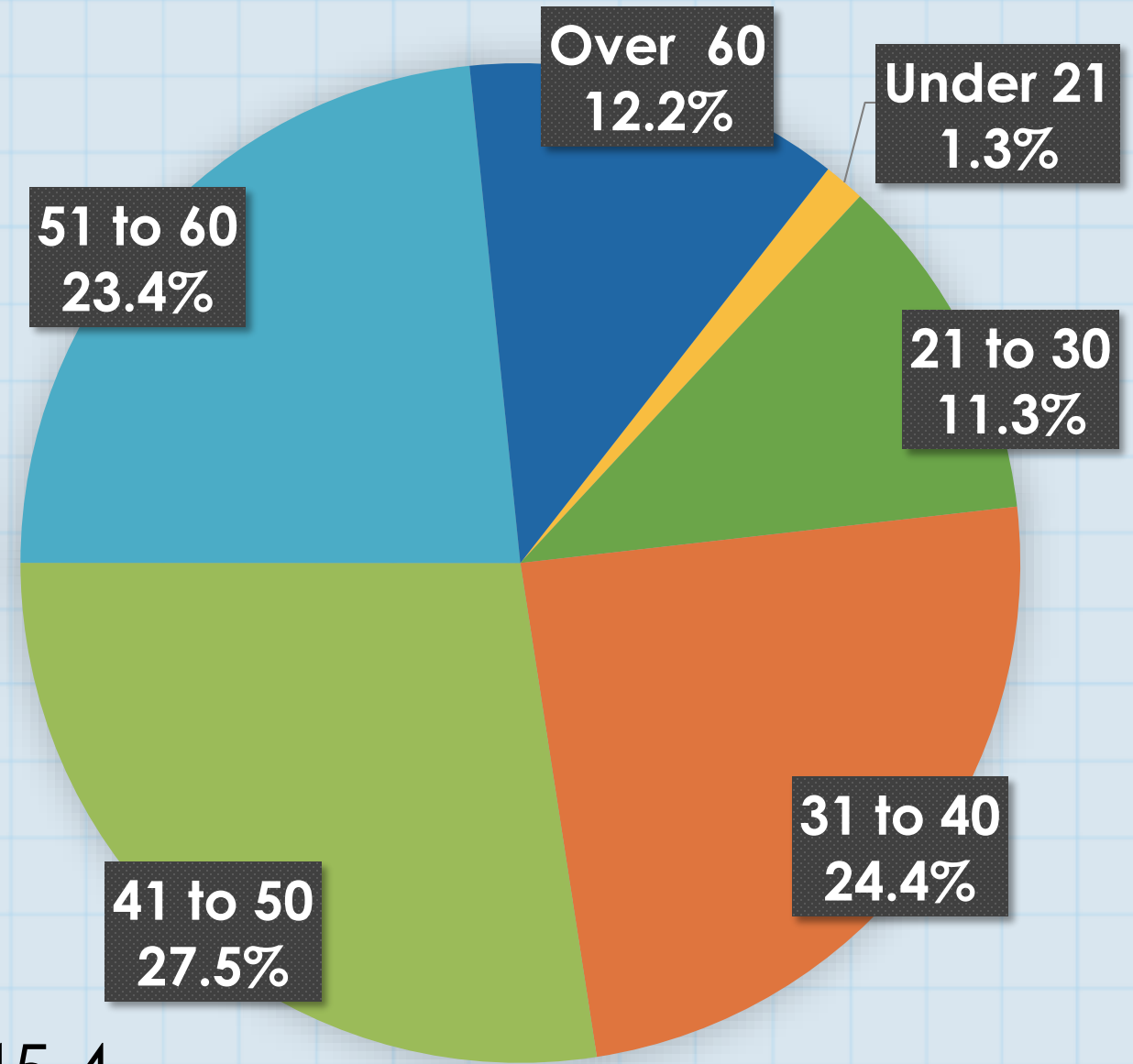
Gender



Female decreased 1% and Other increased 1%.

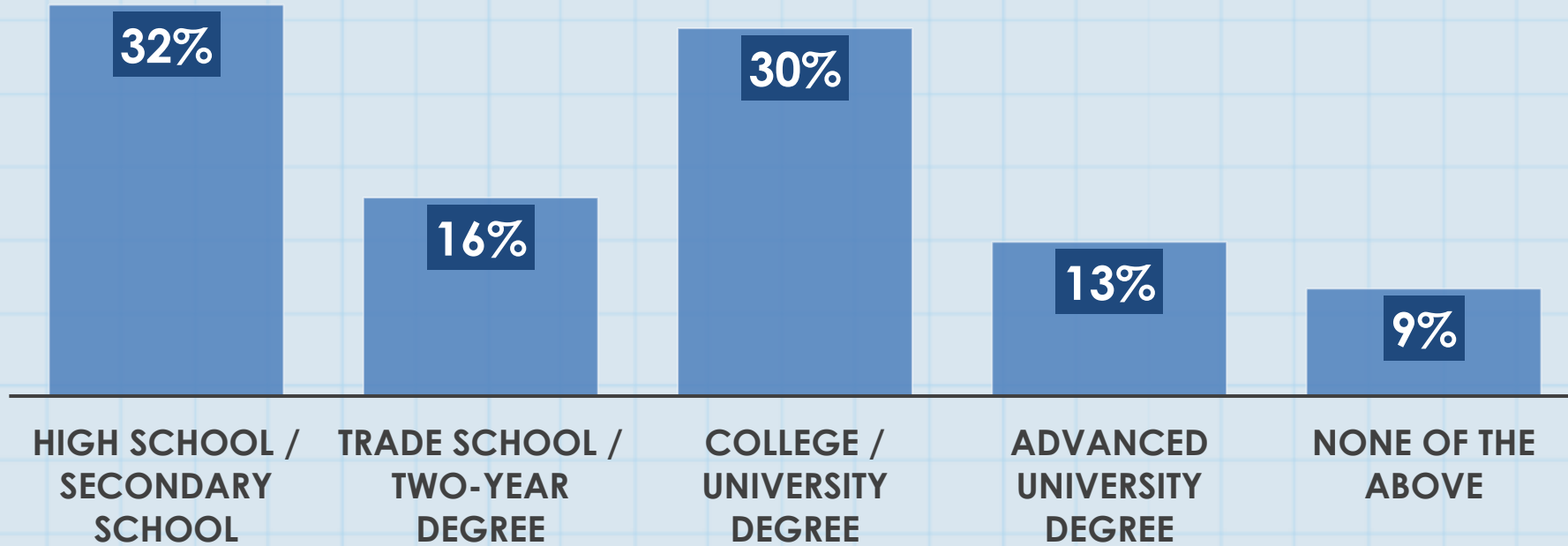

Over 60 increased by 5%.



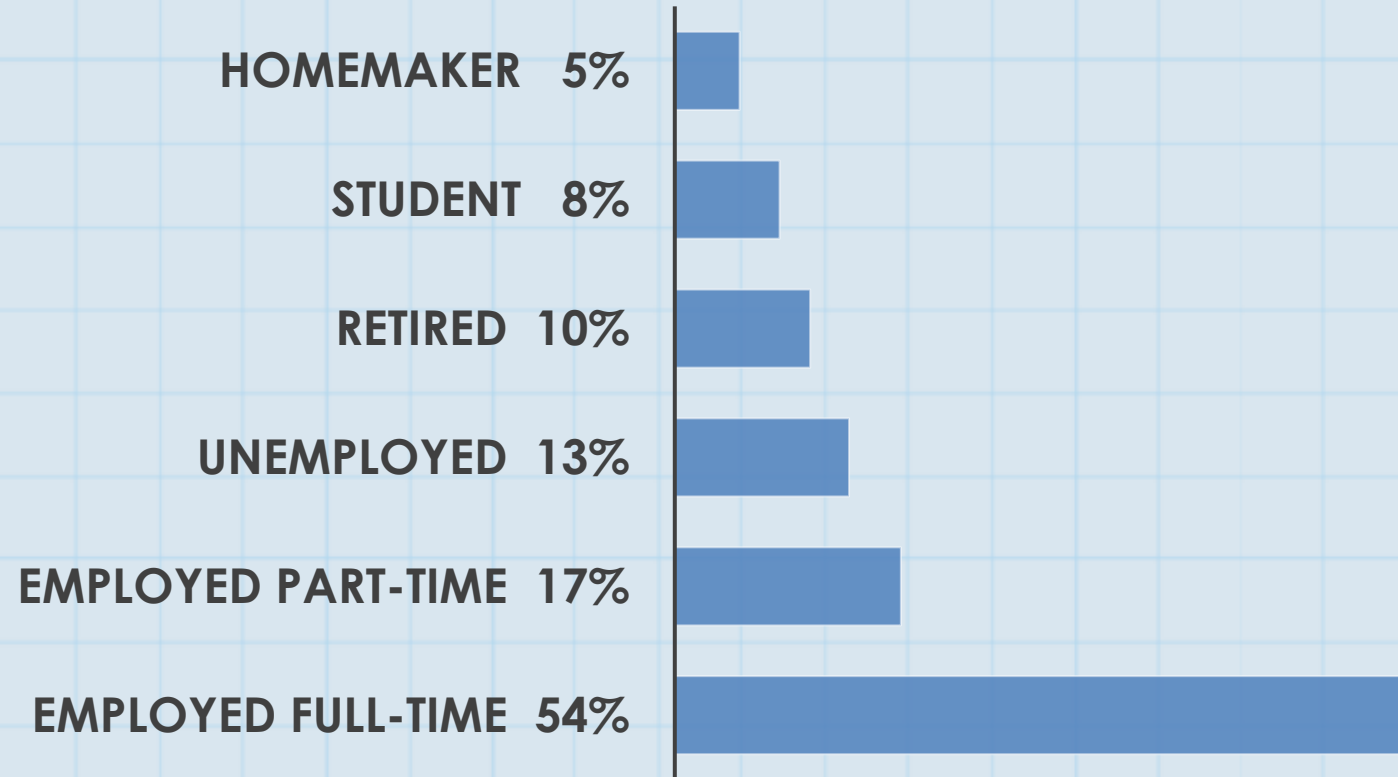

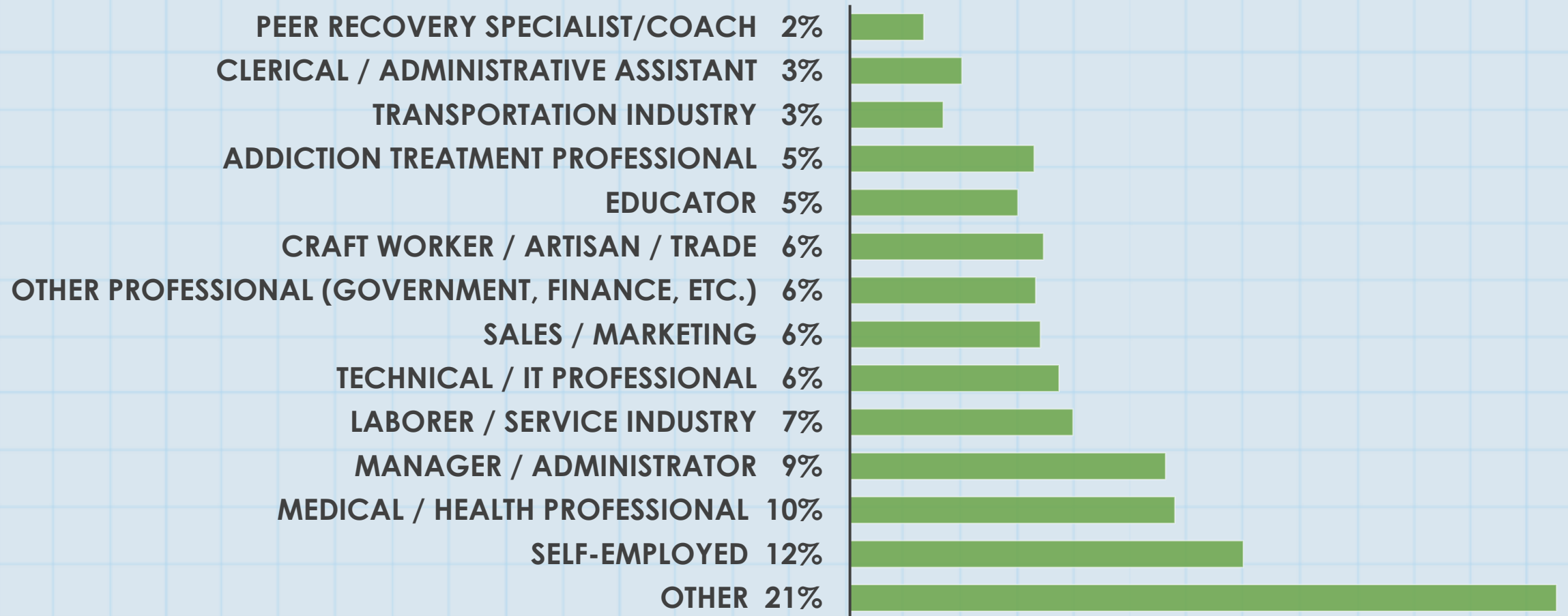

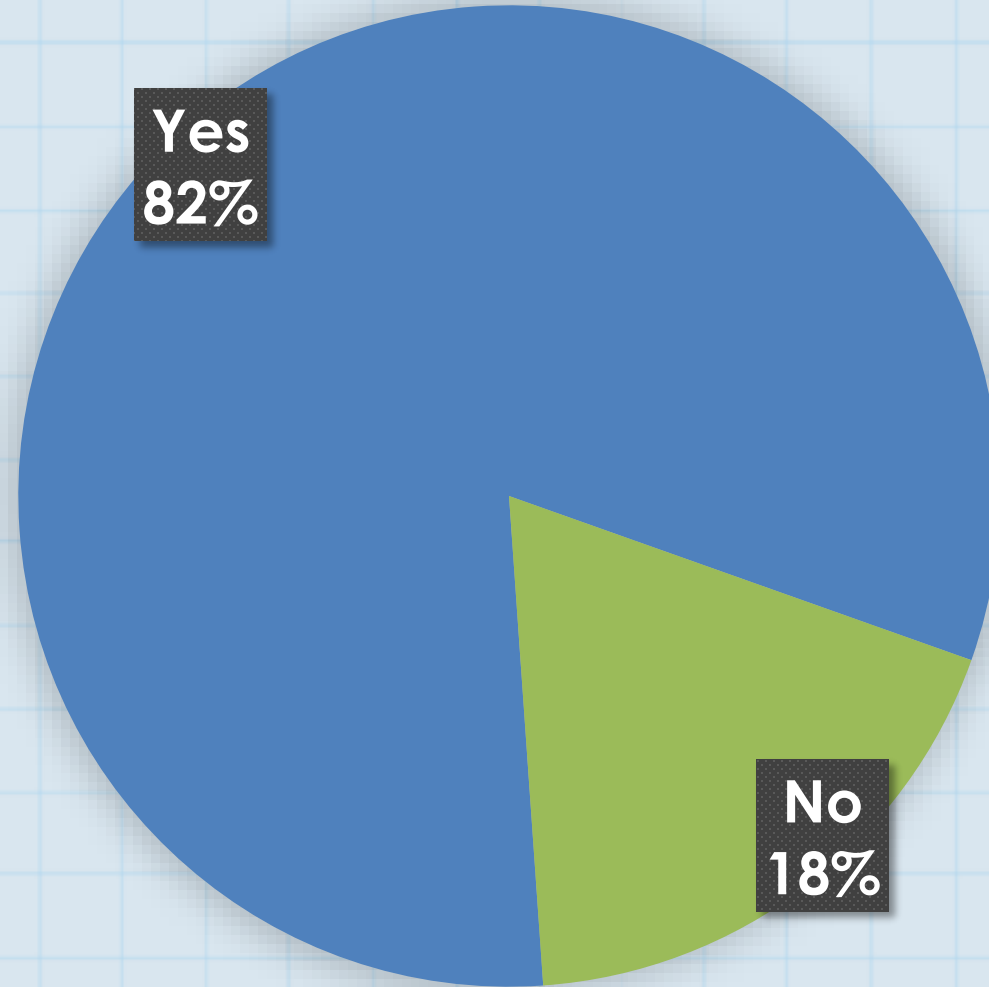

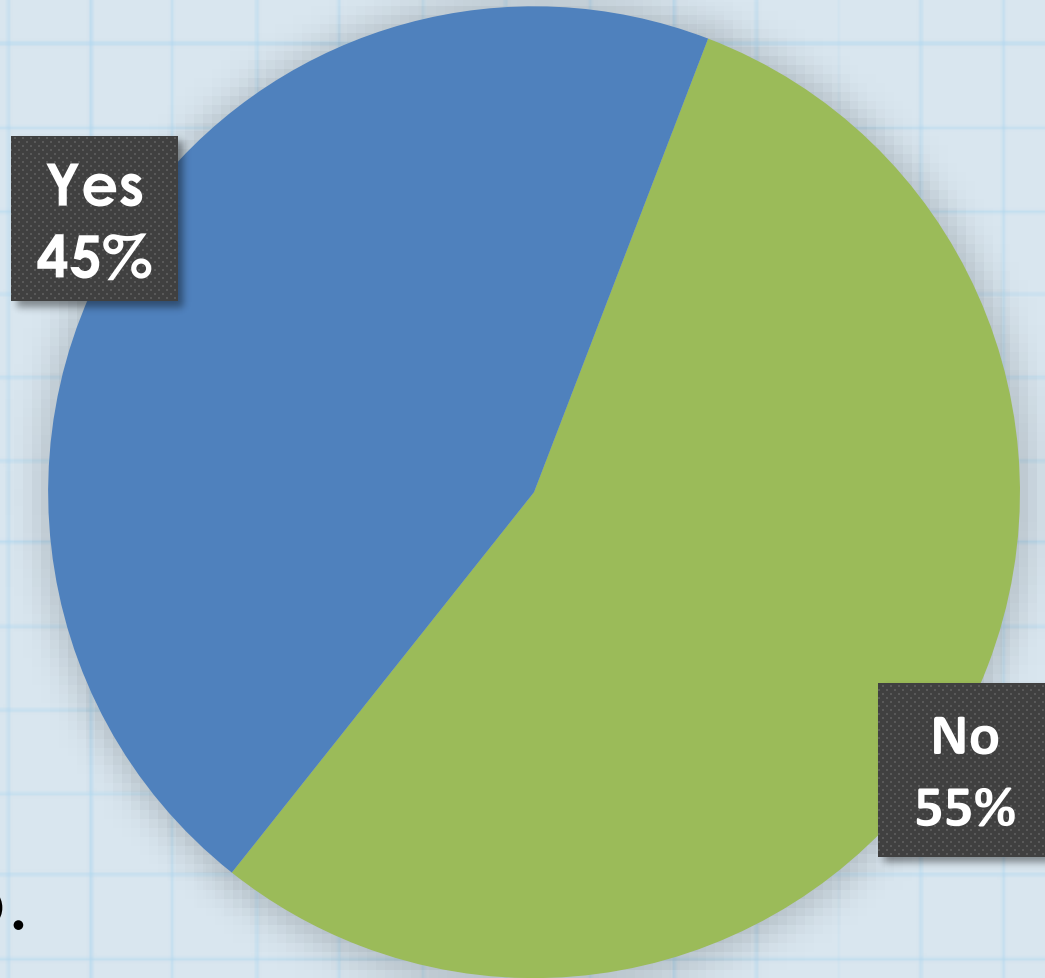

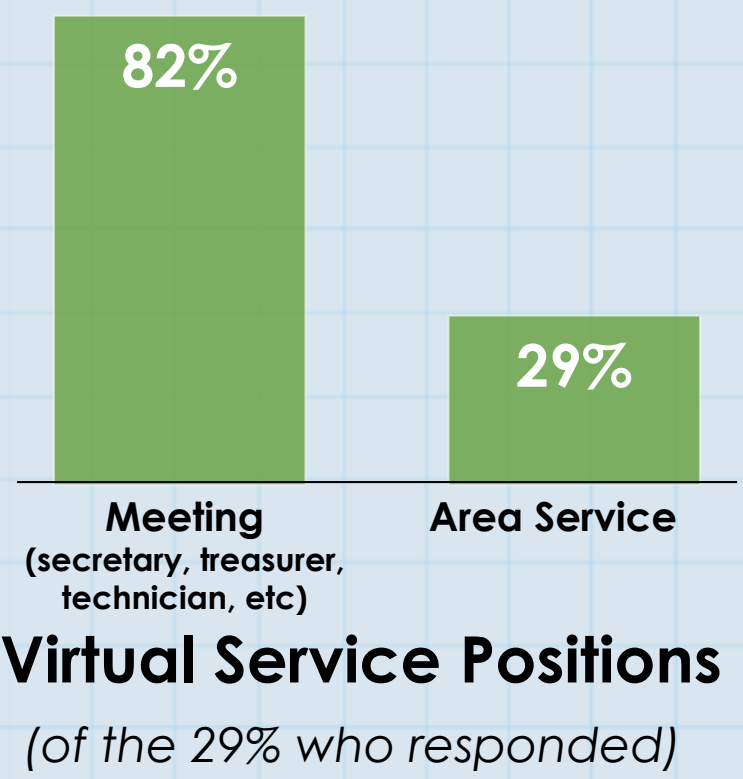

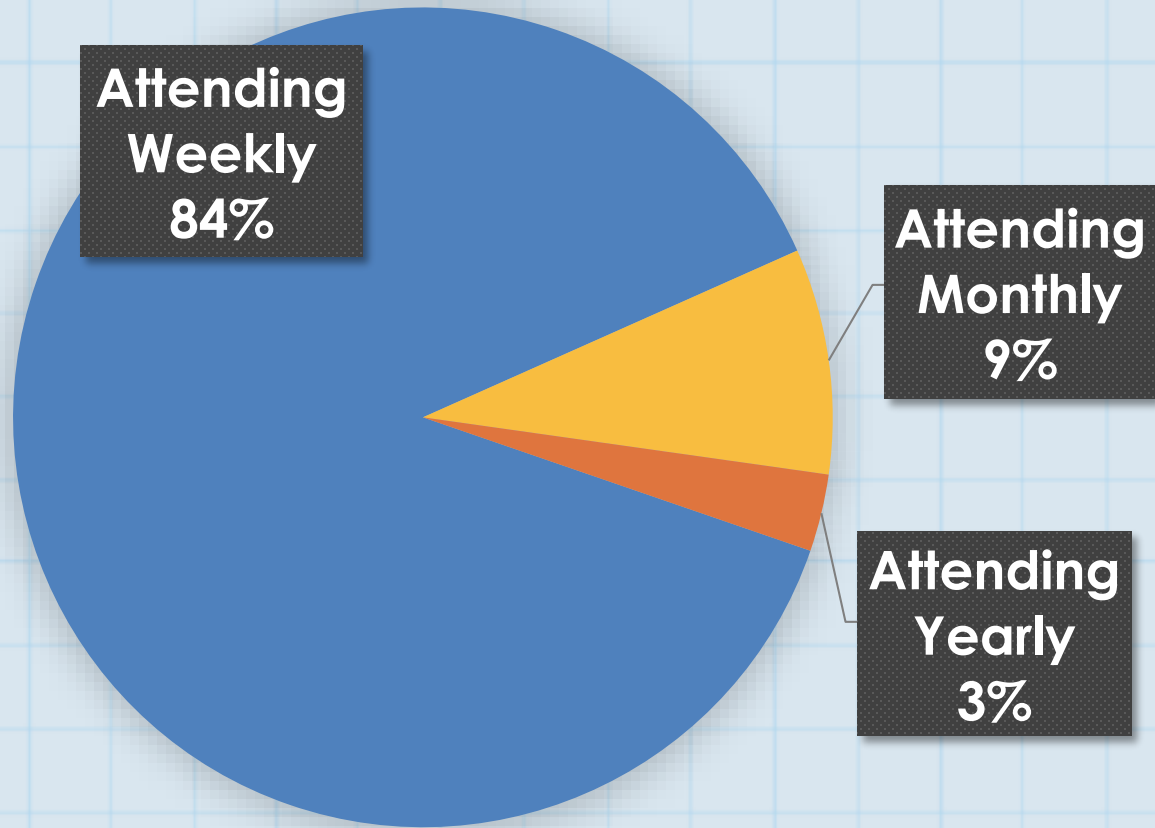

Service Positions Held



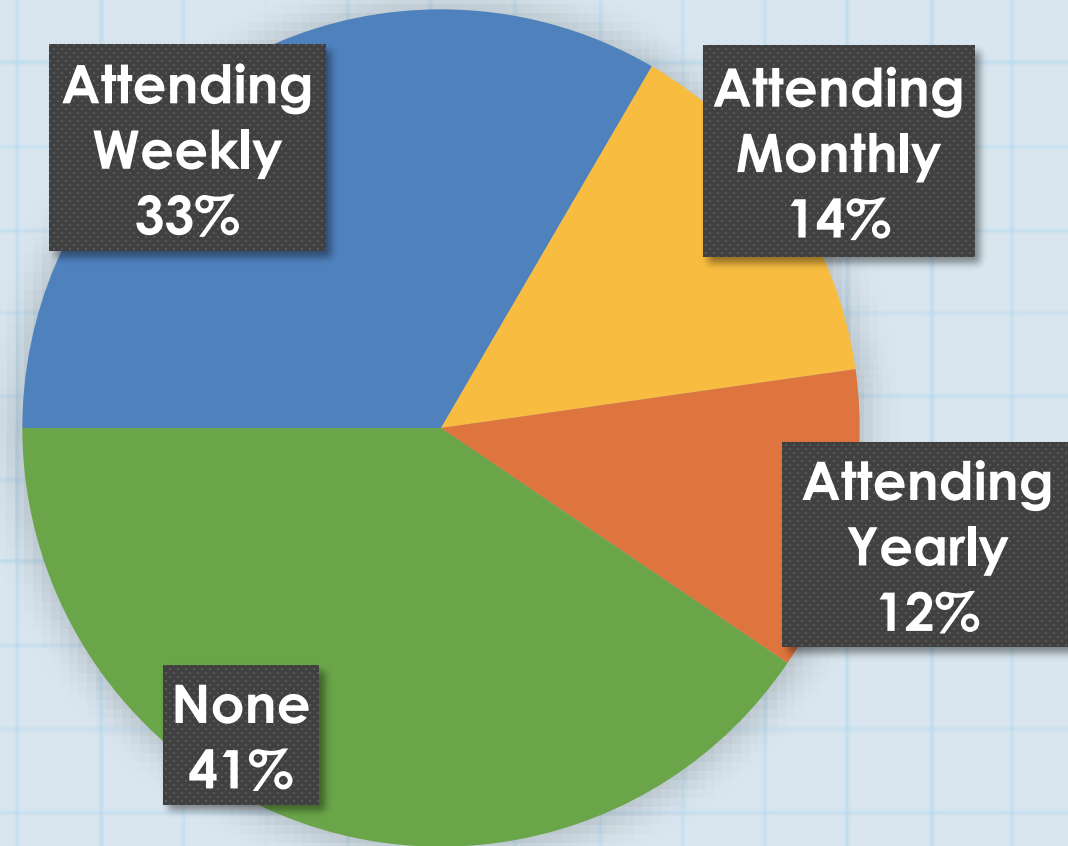
Regional Service decreased 3%; PR decreased 3%; H&I decreased 4%; Area Service decreased 2%; and Convention was a new category for 2024.

Meeting Attendance



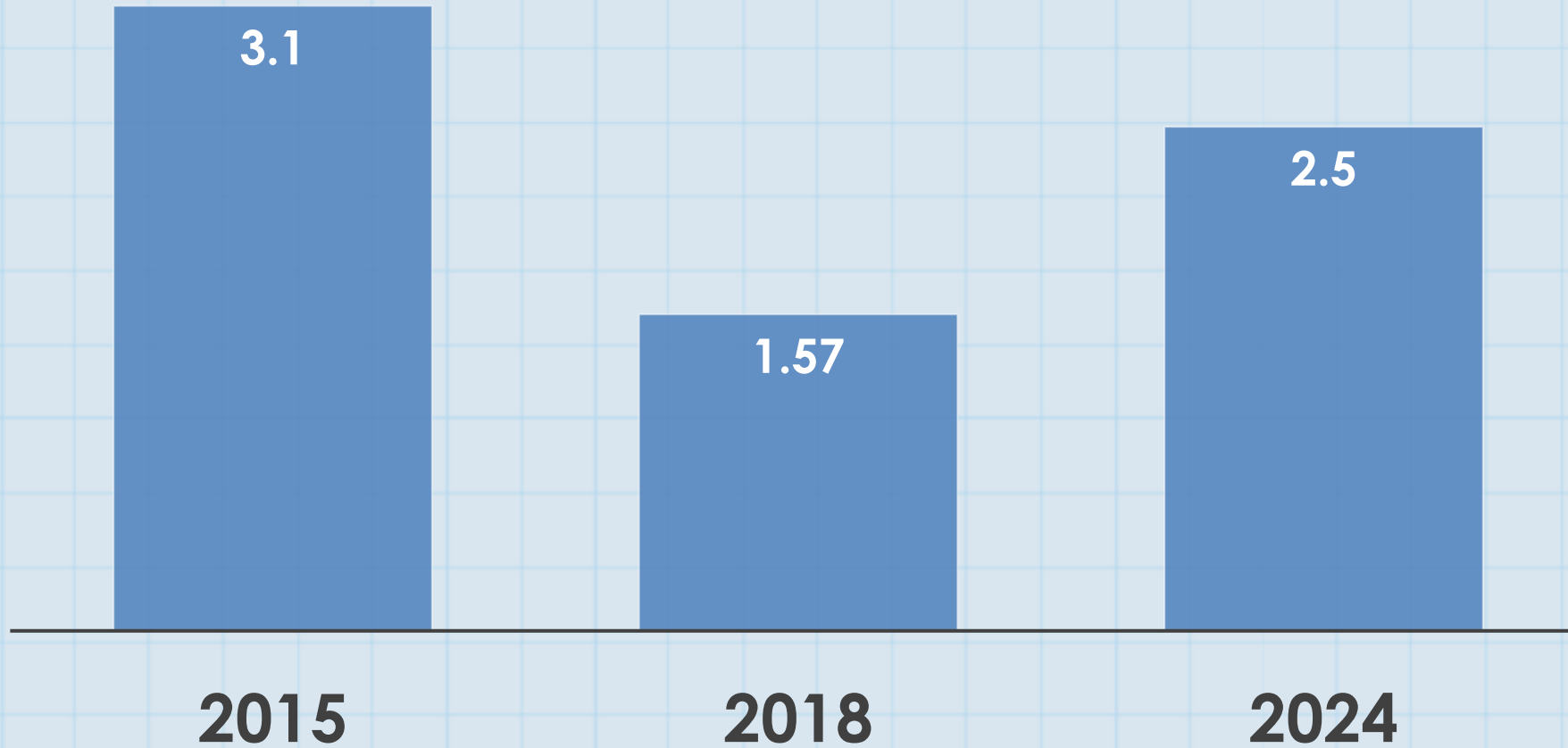

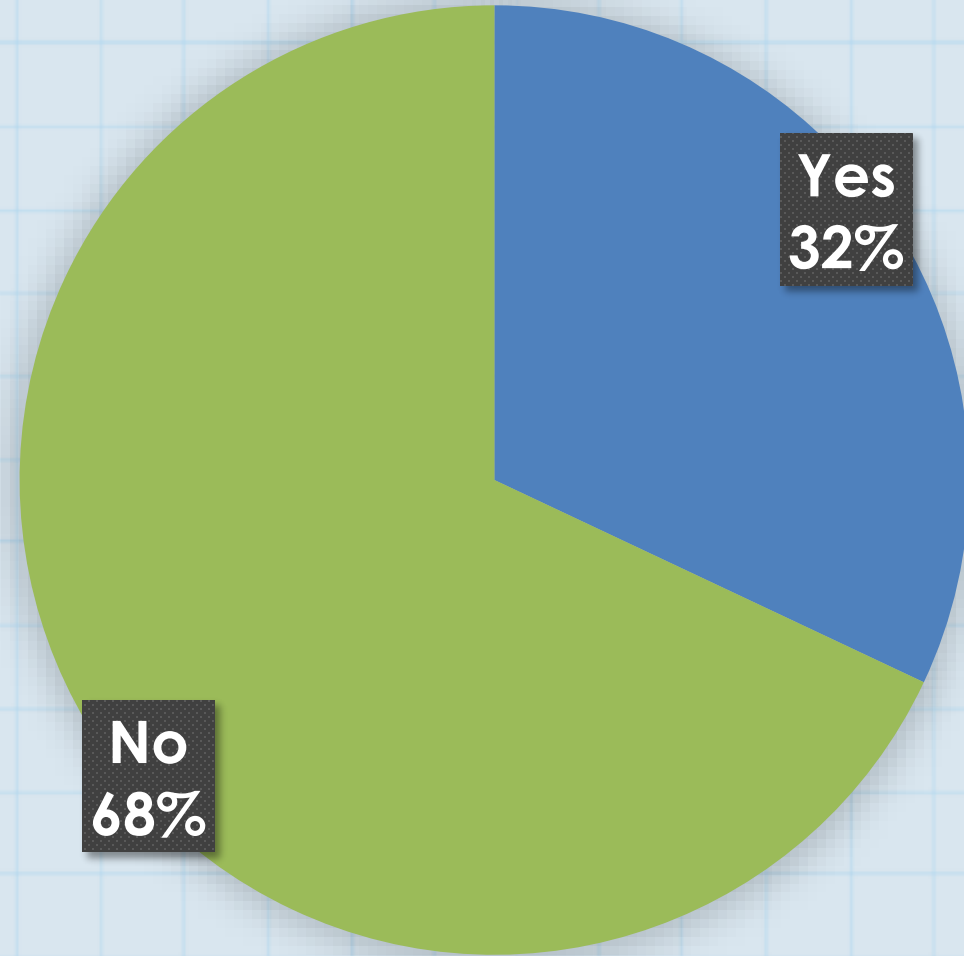

Average Weekly Attendance

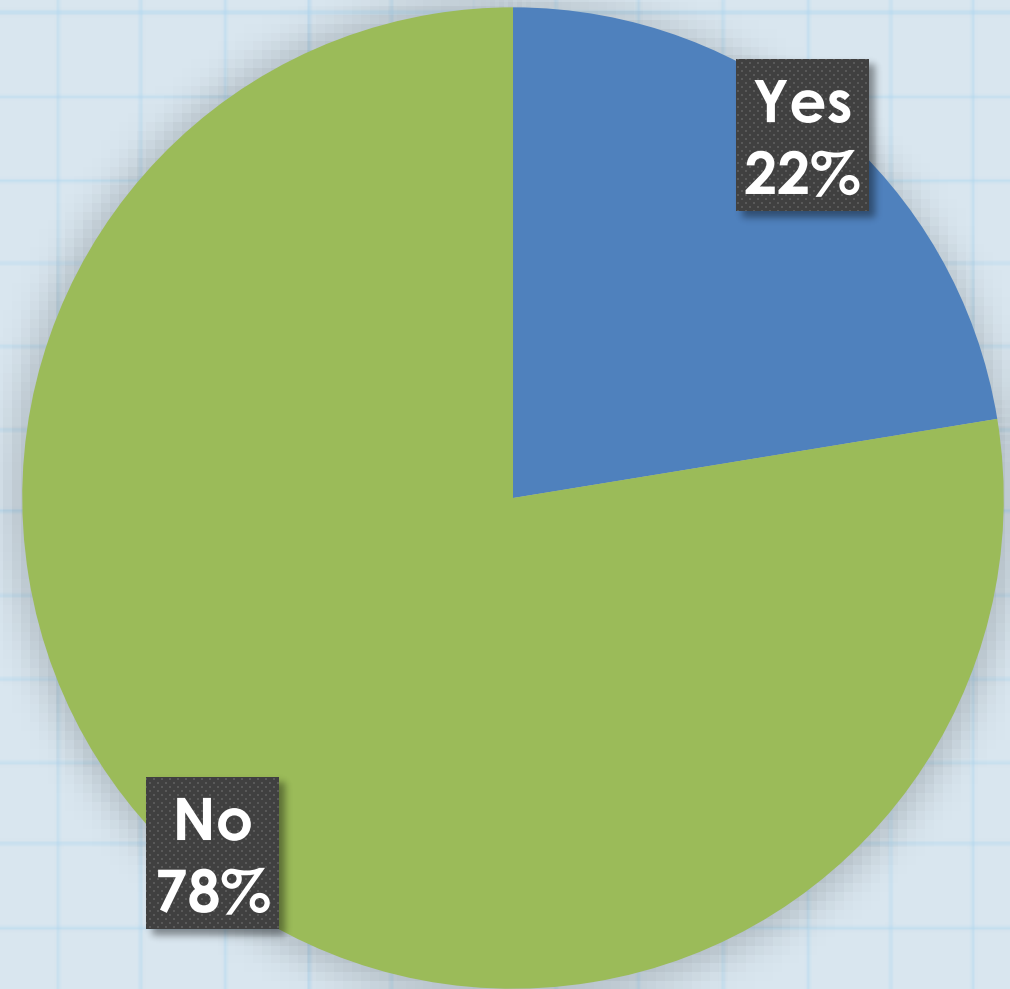


Other Fellowships Attendance

Yes 39% and No 61%.

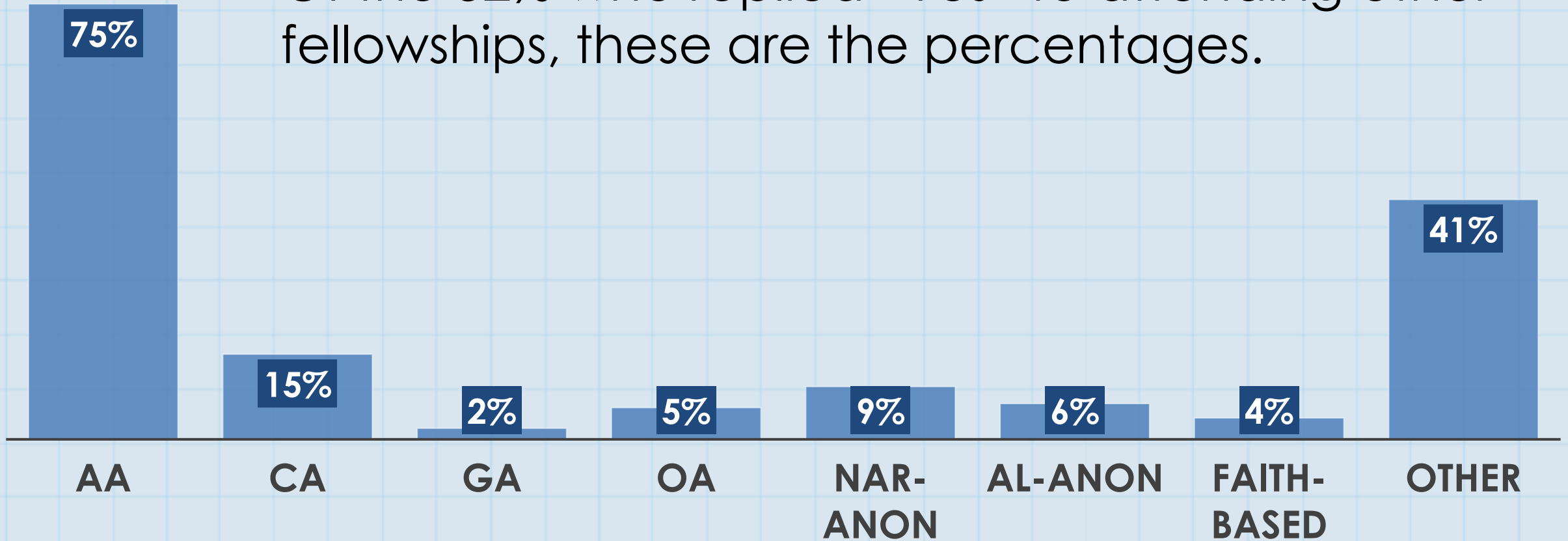
Family Members in 12-Step Fellowships

Of the 32% who replied “Yes” to attending other fellowships, these are the percentages.

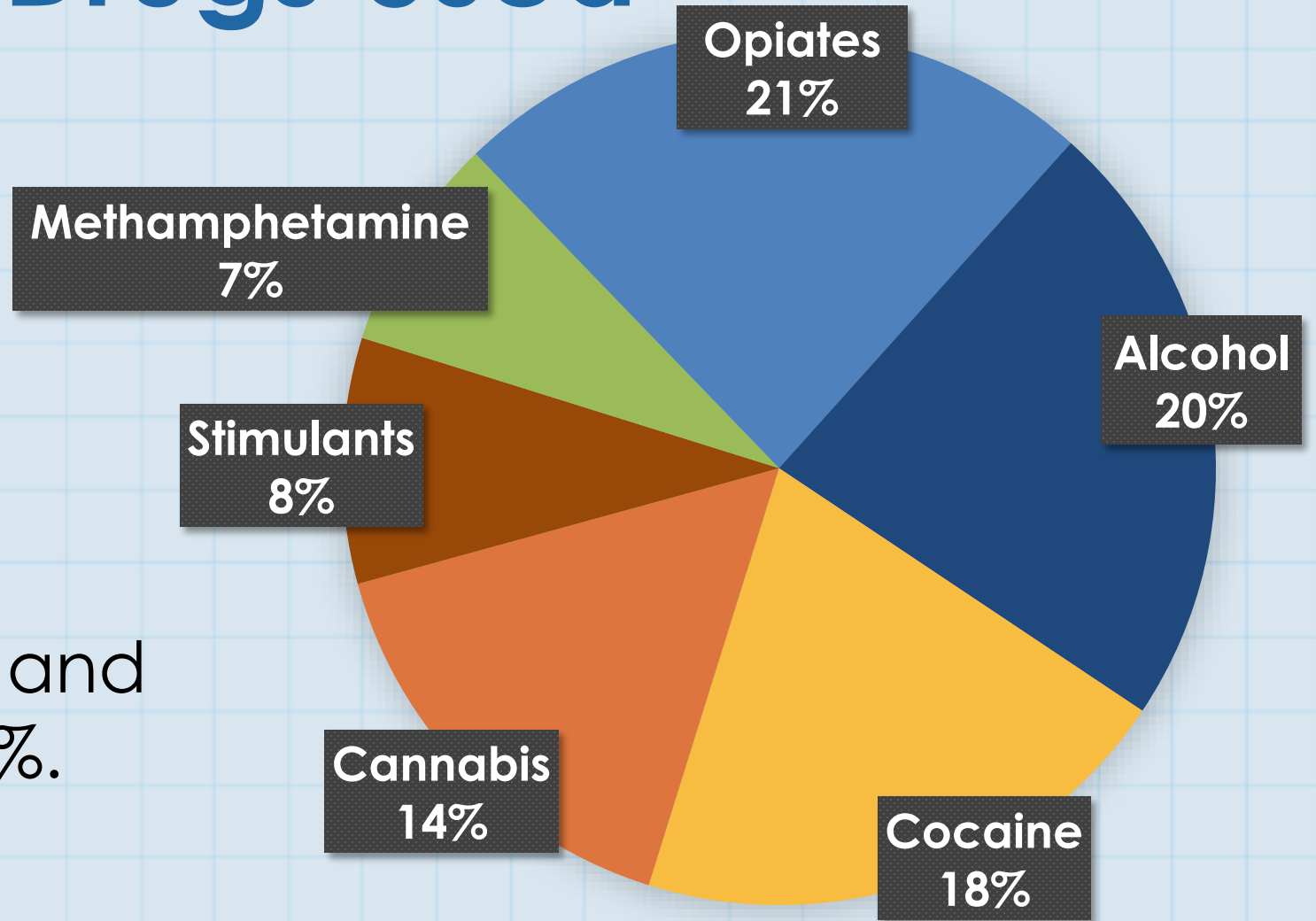

Top 6 Primary Drugs Used

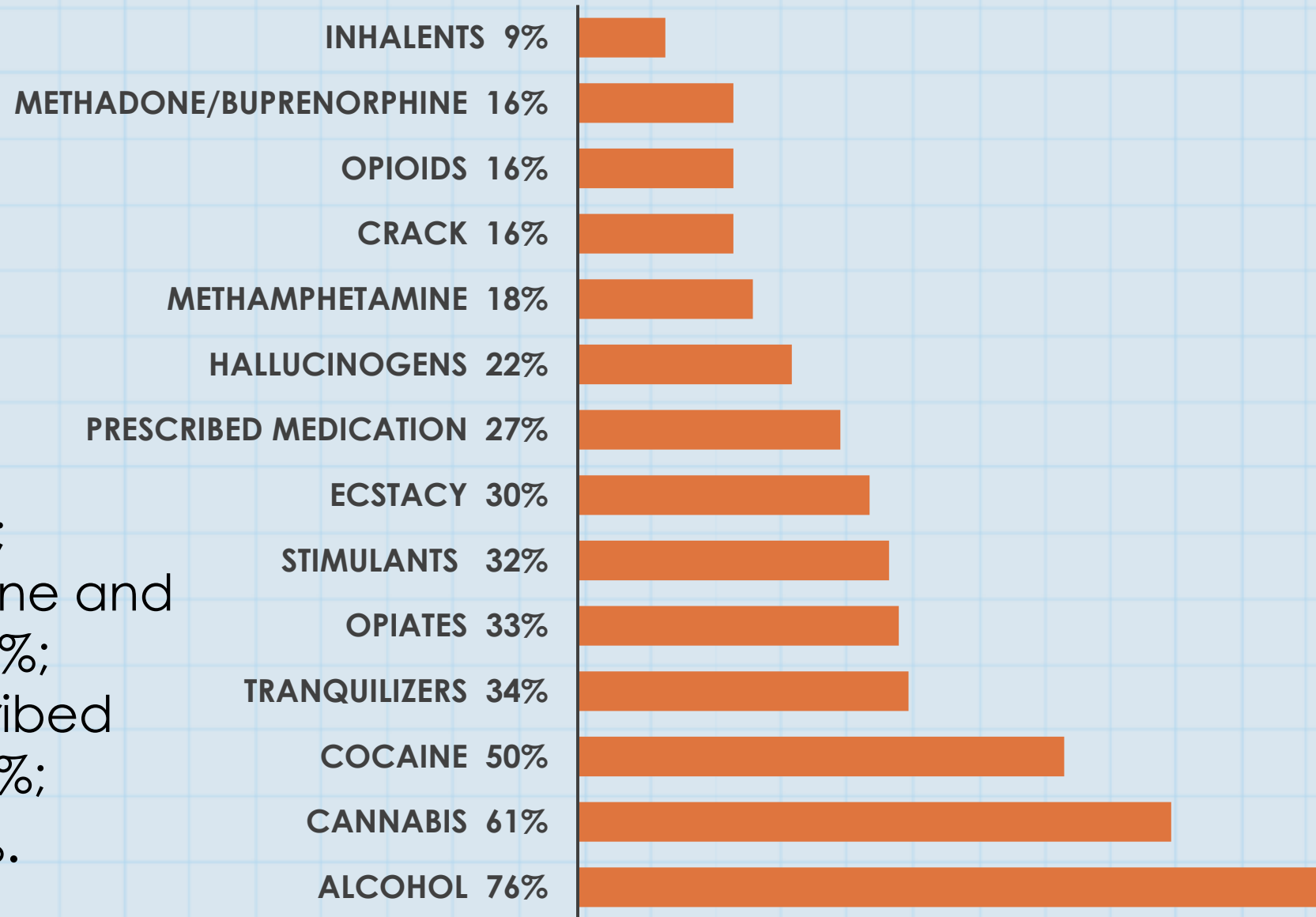
Opiates decreased 8%

include methamphetamine.

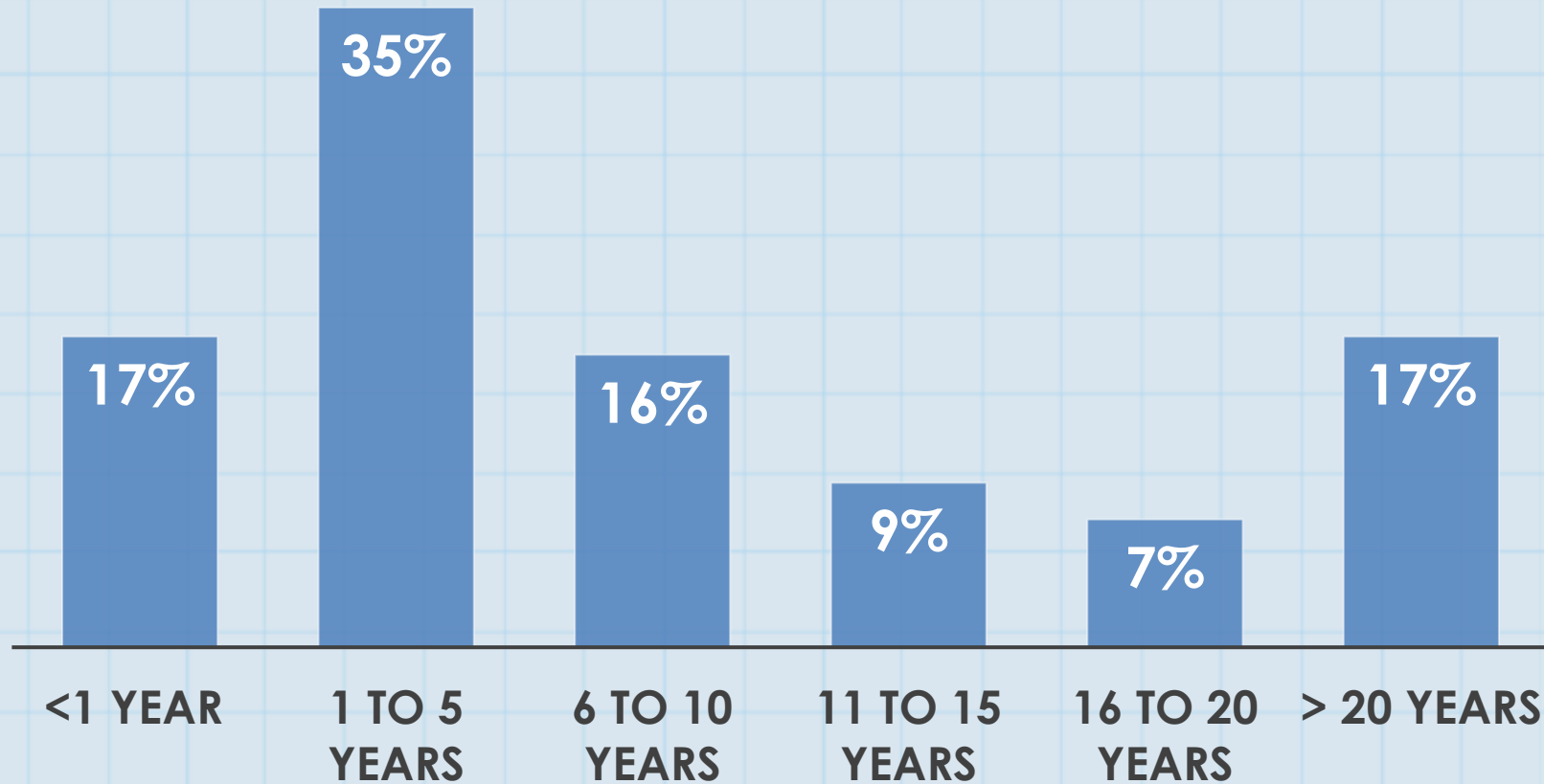


Other Drugs Used Regularly

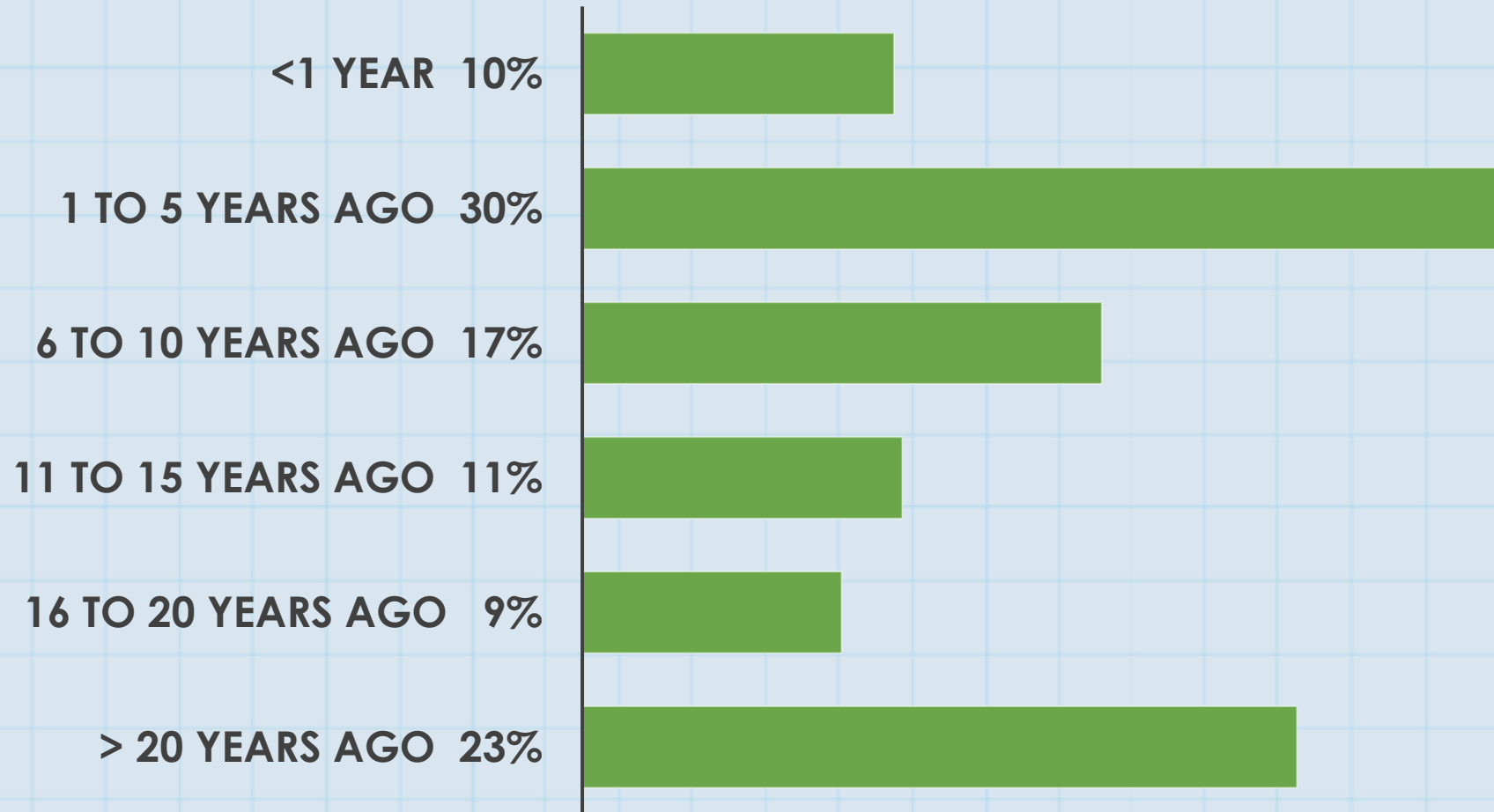

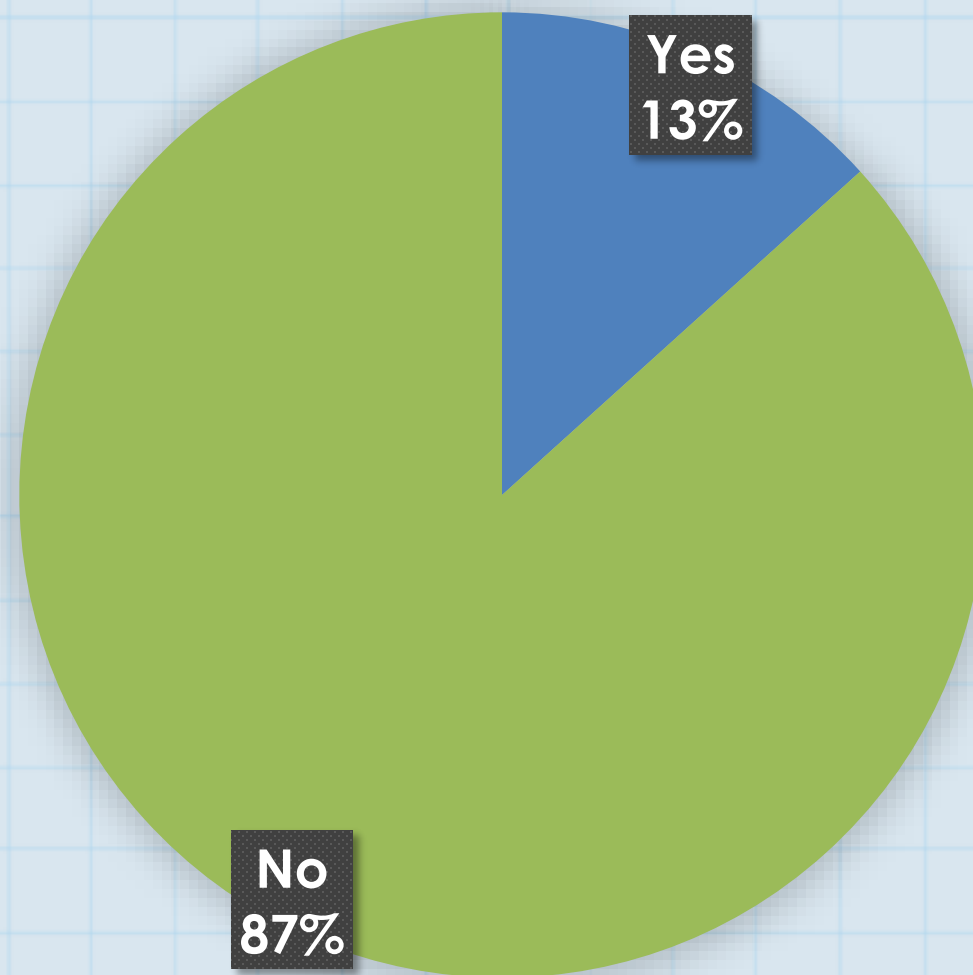
When was your first NA meeting?

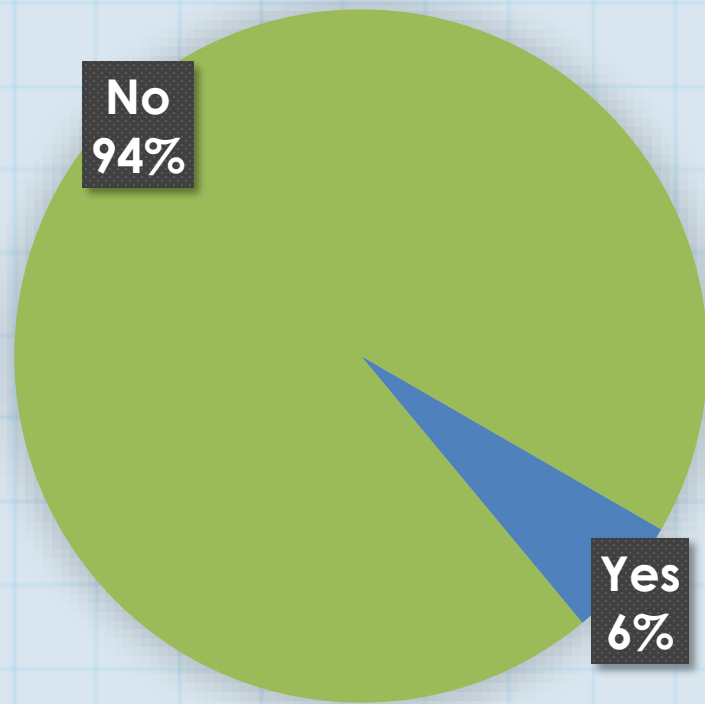

Attended First Meeting on DRT/MAT

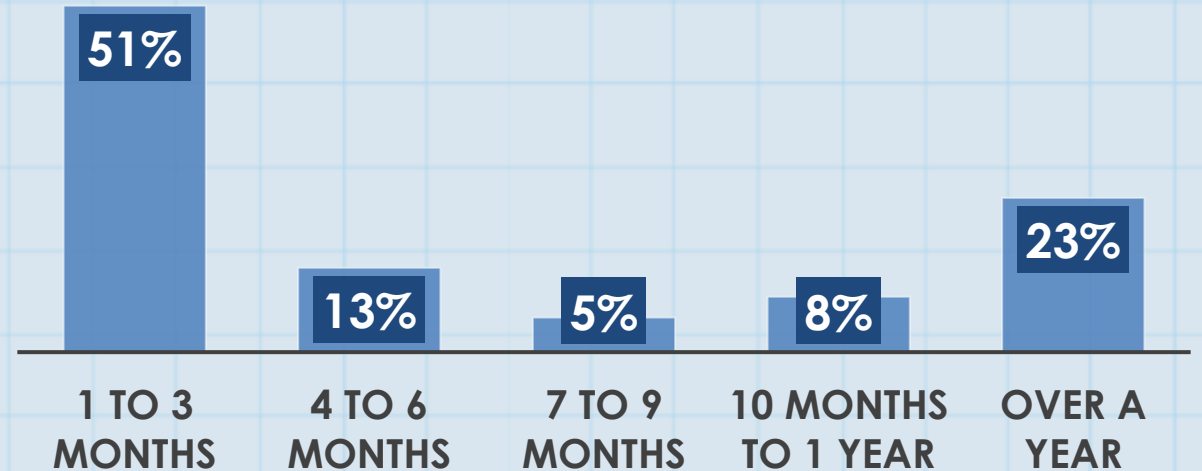

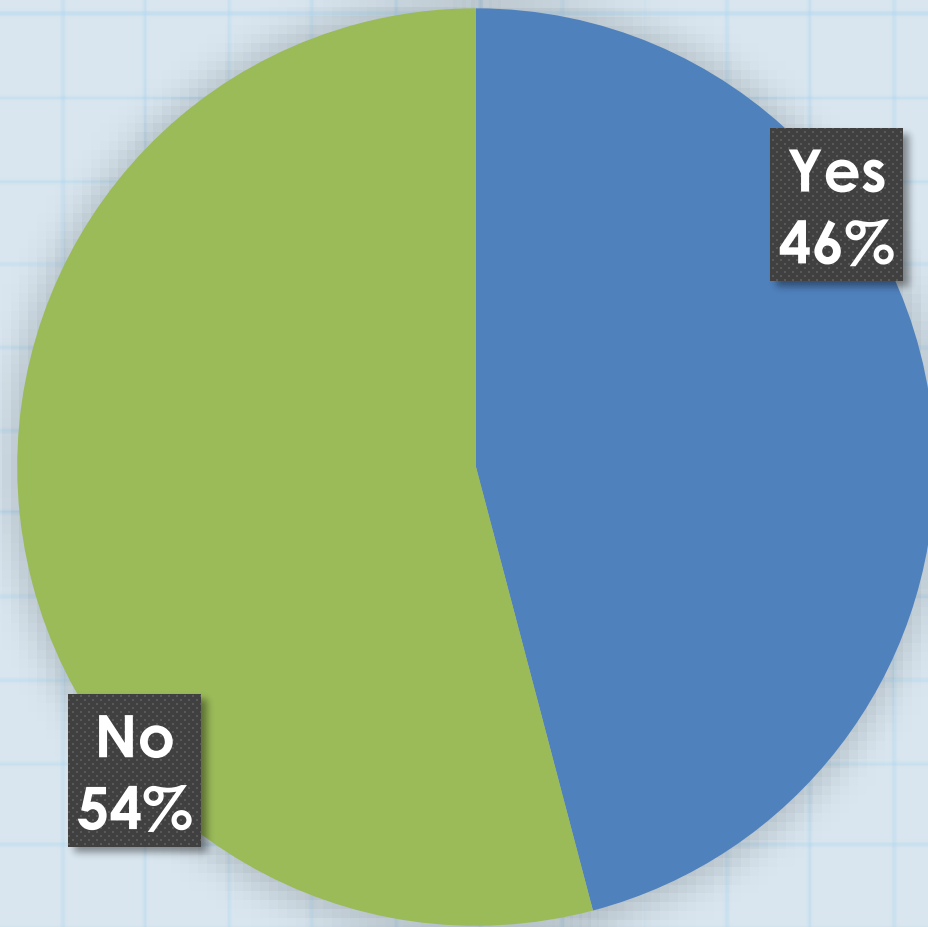
Are you still on DRT/MAT?



If not, how long did you attend NA meetings before getting off DRT/MAT?

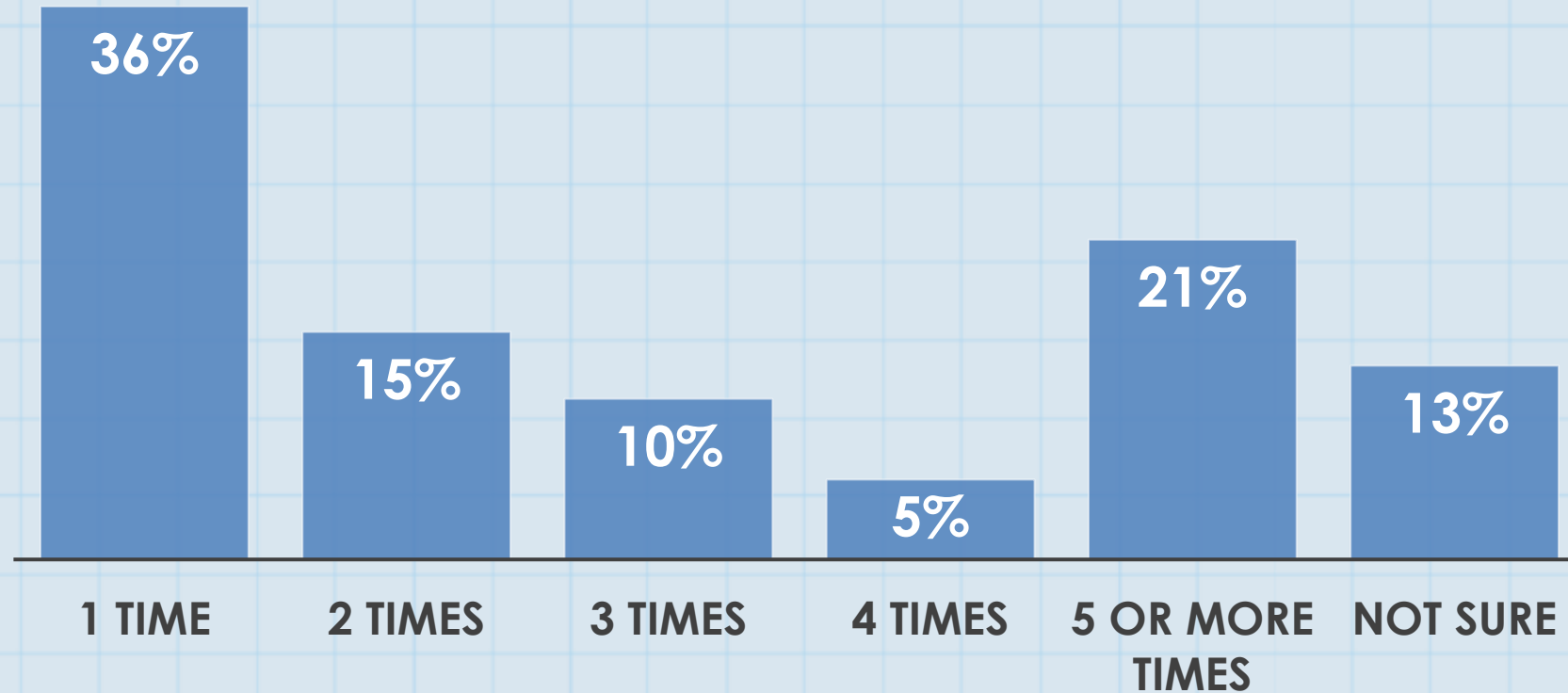


Relapsed since Beginning Recovery



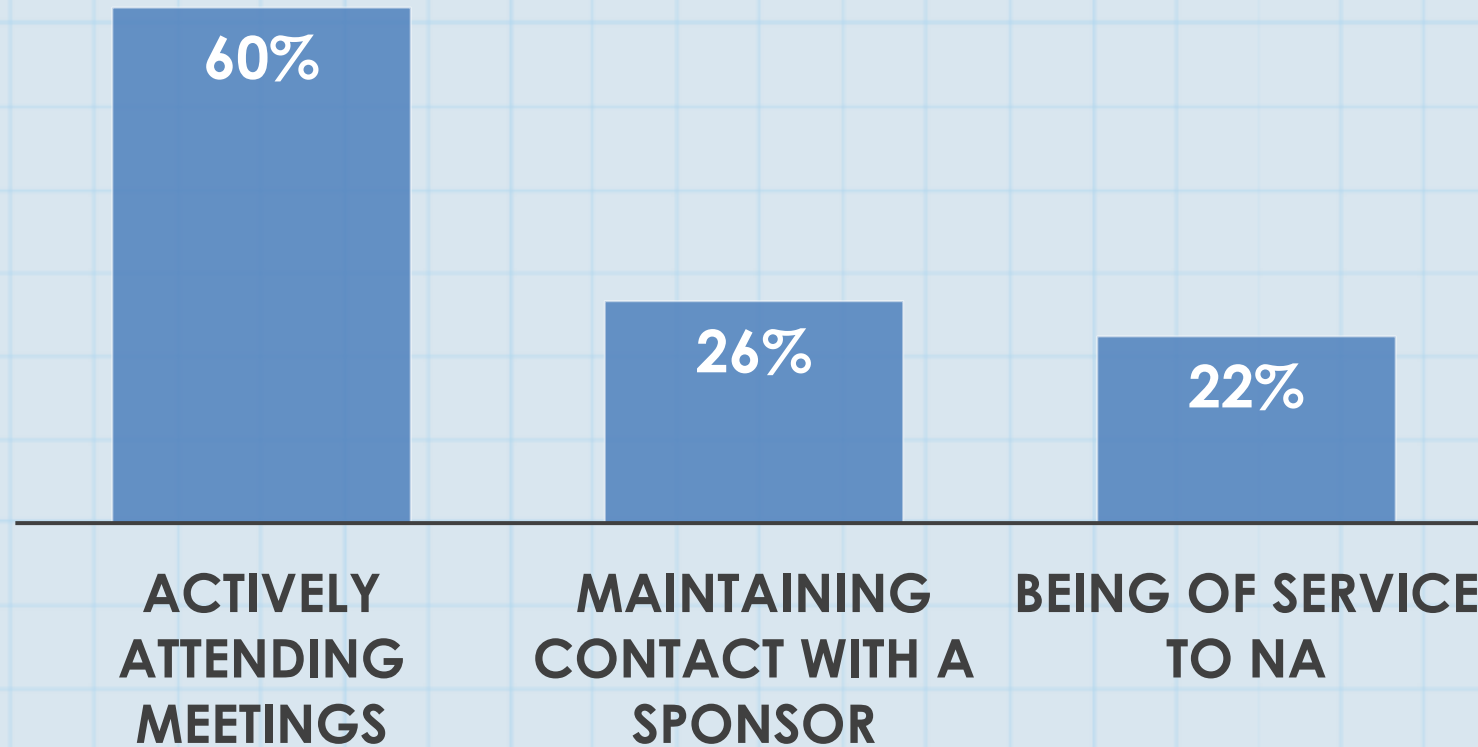

Number of Relapses



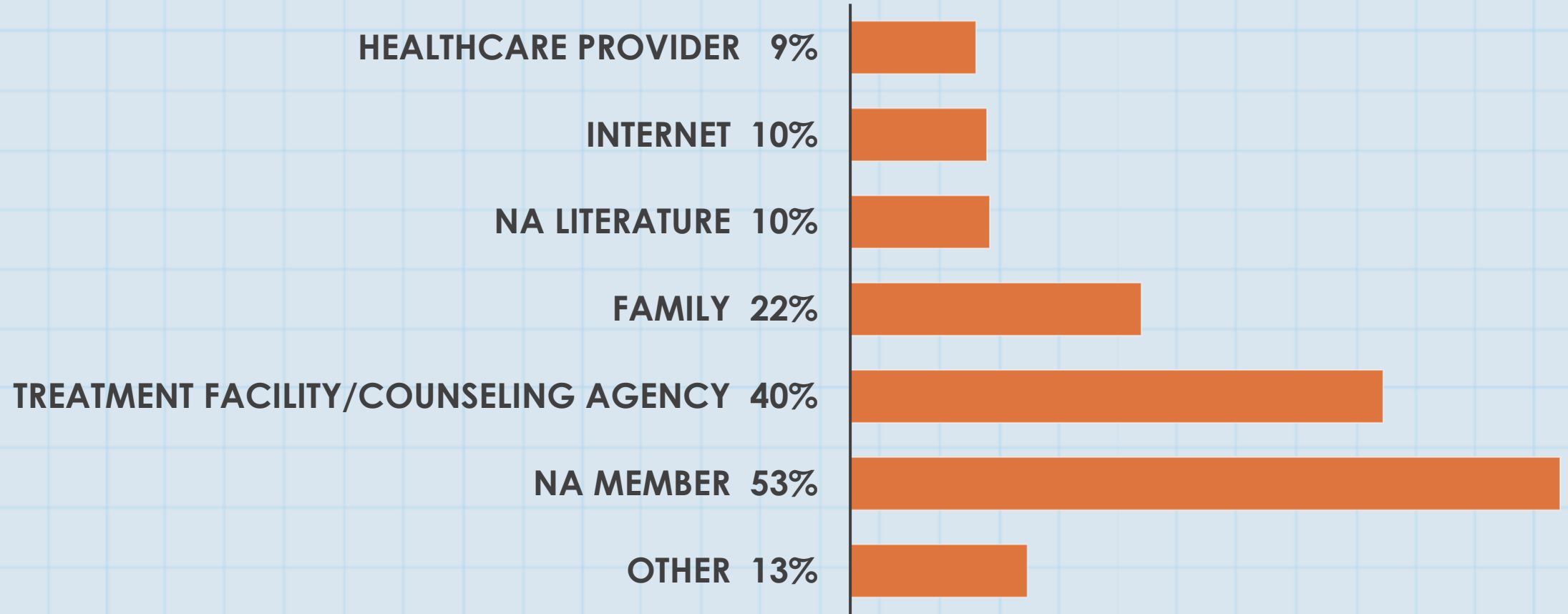

When you Relapsed were you...?



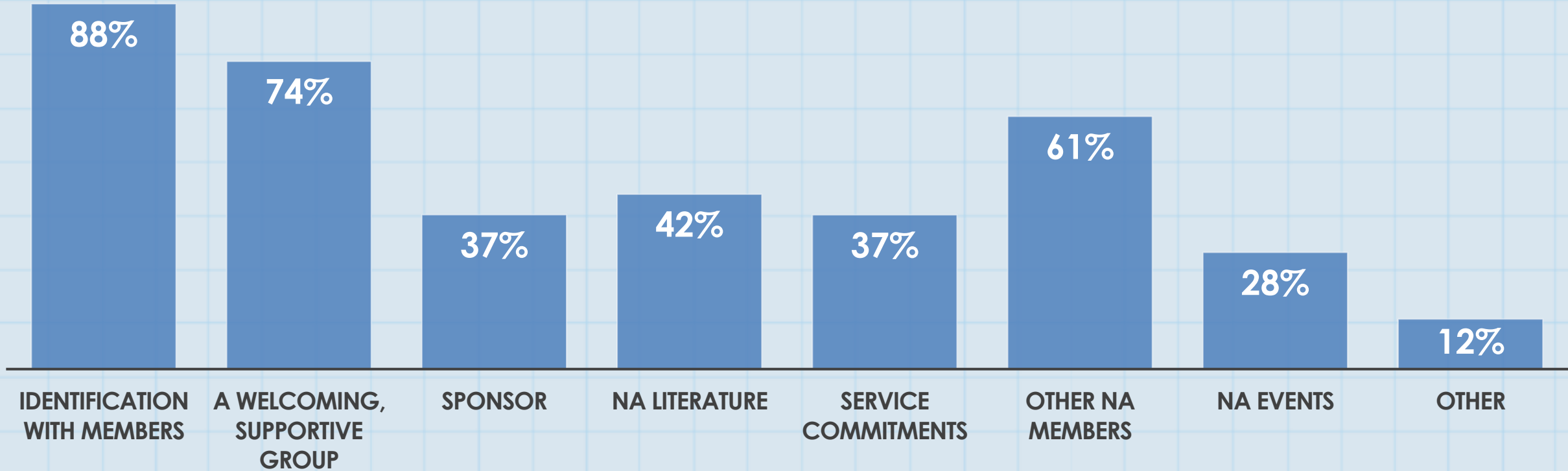
Actively Attending Meetings decreased 1%;

Top 7 Influences to Attend NA



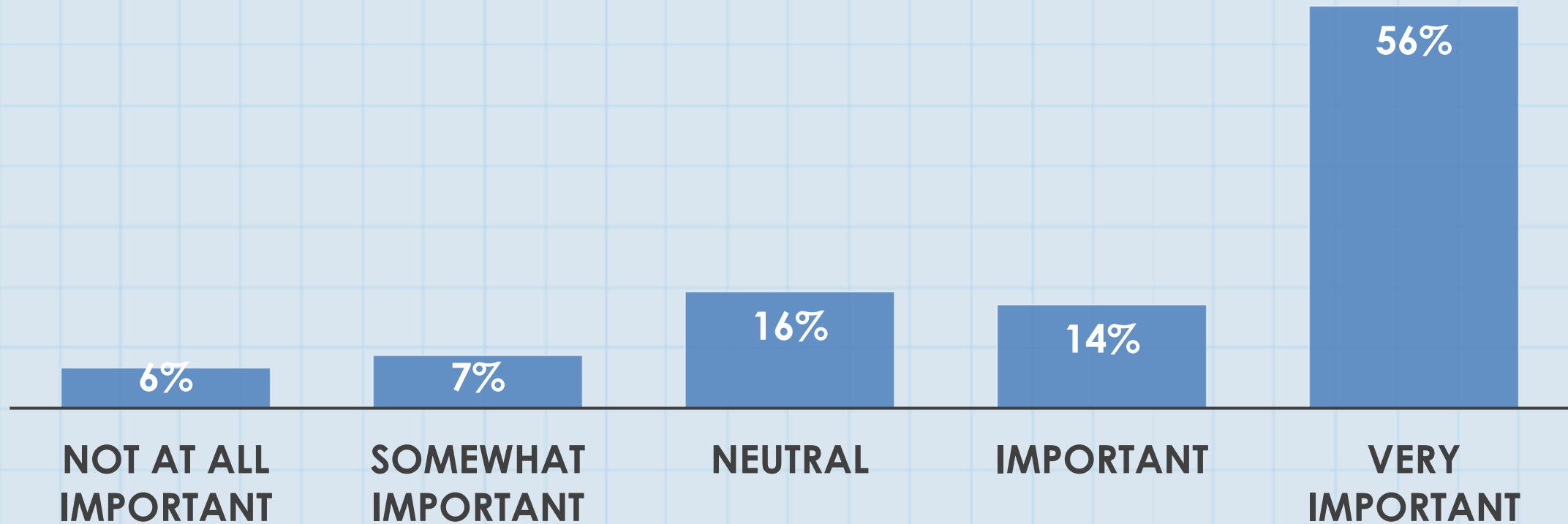

Influences to Stay in NA



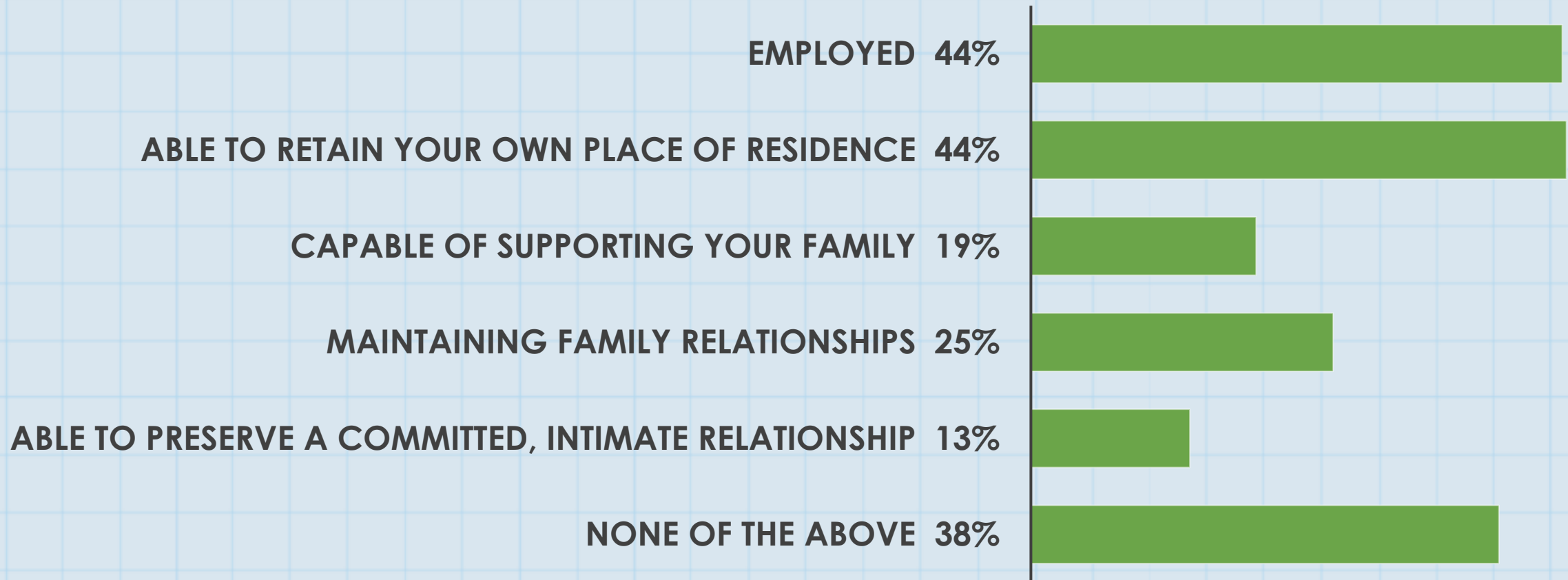

Importance of First NA Meeting



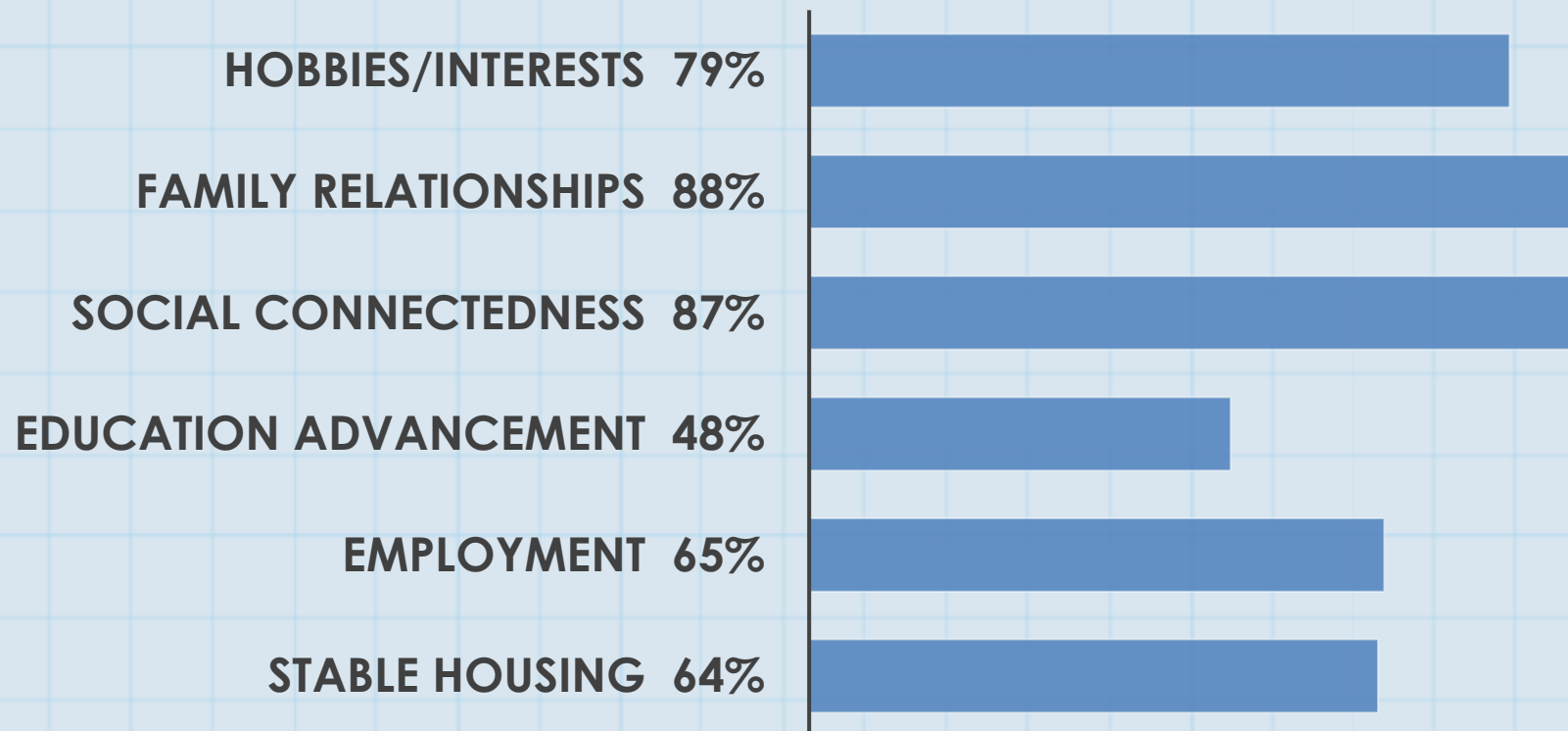
Neutral decreased 2; Important decreased 3%;

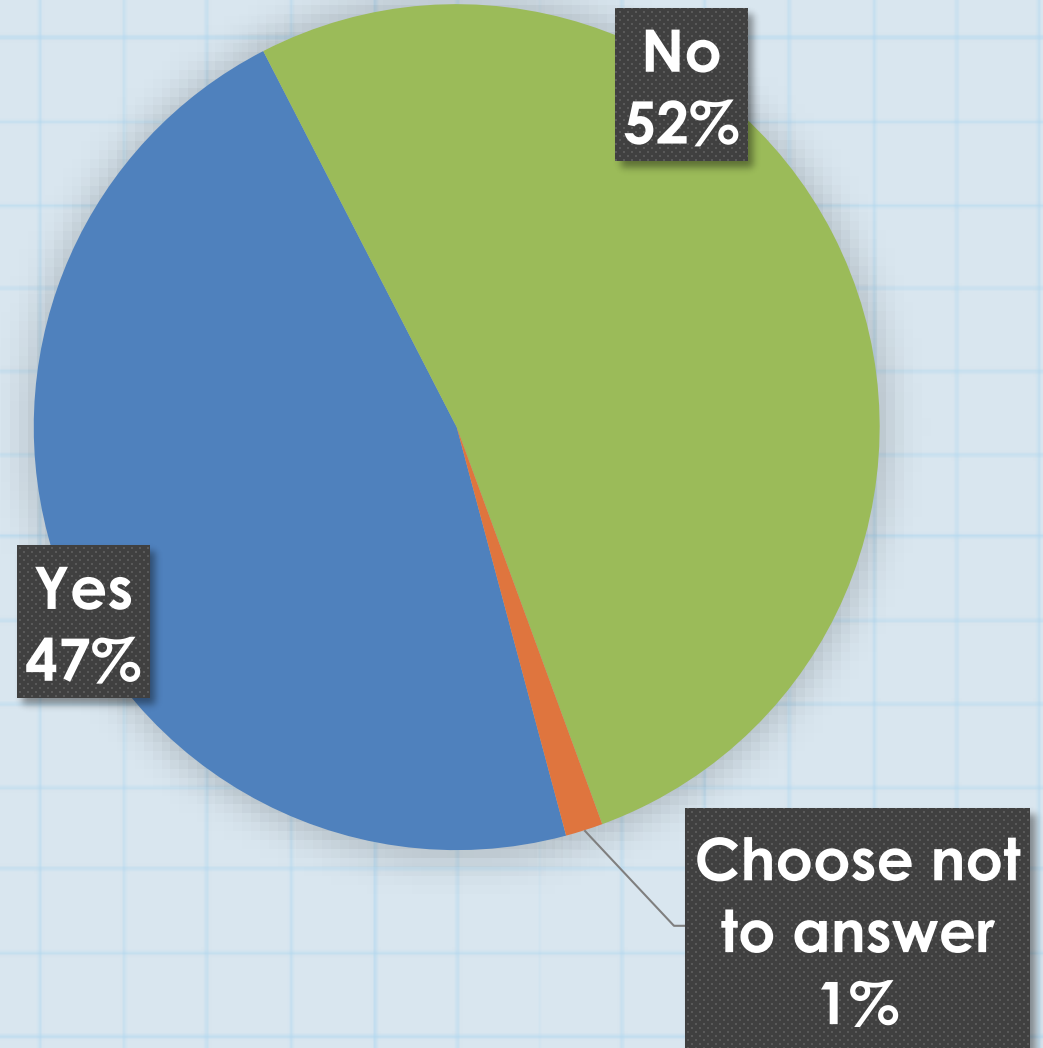

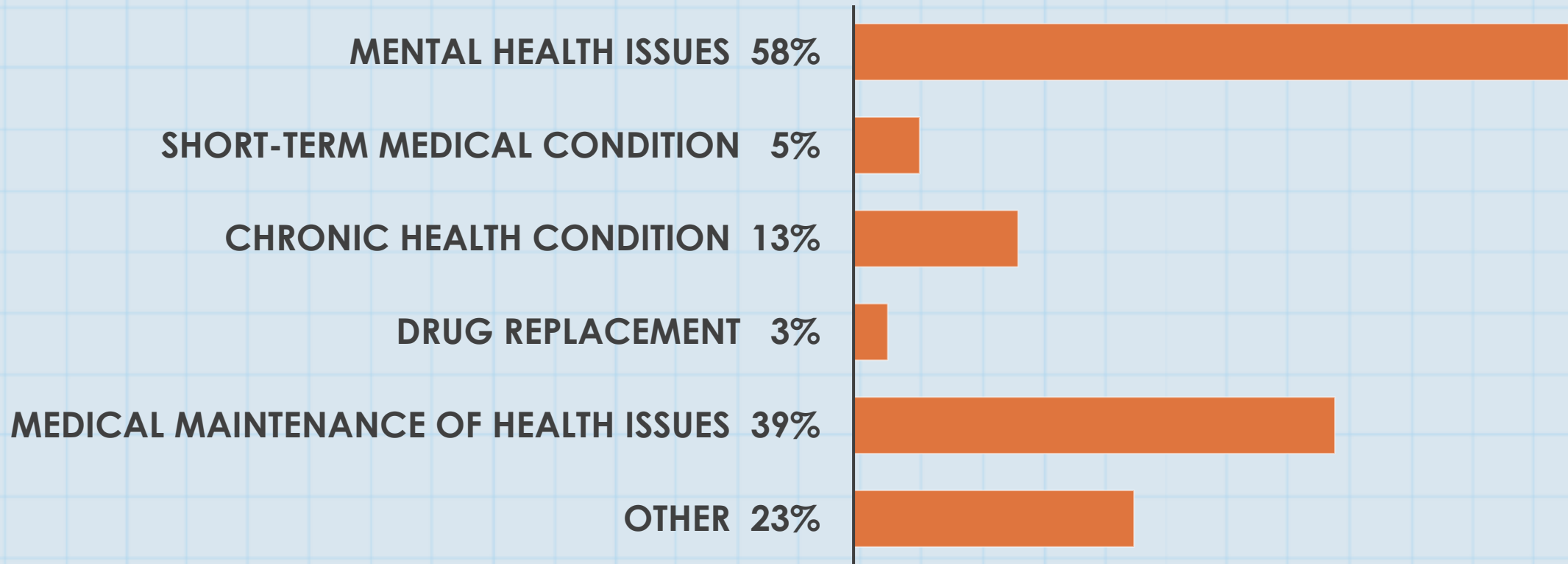
Education decreased 5%; Employment decreased 3%; and Stable Housing decreased 3%.
