



# Gender





Female increased 2% from 2018 without Iran.

With Iran, there is 39% female, 60% males, and 1% other.


Throughout this presentation, comparisons to 2018 are percentages based on total respondents, not actual totals from year to year.

# Service Positions Held




**None increased from 1% to 23%;** H&I decreased by 2%;




# Are you sponsoring others?

# Age


21–30 decreased by 6%;


# Education Level

Without Iran it decreased 1%.




HS/Secondary School increased by 2%,

# Employment Status





# Professions





# Meeting Attendance




Weekly attendance  
decreased 4%




# Meeting Attendance—Europe



# Average Weekly Attendance




# Other Fellowships Attendance

# Family Members in 12-Step Fellowships




The survey in 2018 had

AA stayed the same; Faith-based decreased 2%; Other increased 27% (2018 was a 15% decrease).




AA increased 4% and Other decreased 3% without Iran.


# Top 6 Primary Drugs Used

Opiates decreased 1% (without Iran this would have been a decrease of 6%); Cocaine increased 1%; and Alcohol increased 1%.

This is the first survey to include methamphetamine.




# Top 6 Primary Drugs Used—Europe




# Other Drugs Used Regularly


Without Iran the percentages would be higher for Alcohol (70%), Cannabis (58%), and Cocaine (52%) but lower for Opiates (29%).

# Years Clean






# When was your first NA meeting?



# Attended First Meeting on DRT/MAT



# Are you still on DRT/MAT?




# If not, how long did you attend NA meetings before getting off DRT/MAT?




Without Iran, 1–3 months is 47% and 4–6 months is 13%.

# Relapsed since Beginning Recovery




Yes decreased 4% and No increased 4% from 2018






Without Iran, NA Member would

# Influences to Stay in NA




Identification increased 1% (without Iran increase 3%);  
Welcoming Group increased 2% (without Iran increase 6%);  
Sponsor increased 3%;  
NA Literature increased 3%; and  
Service increased 5%.

# Importance of First NA Meeting




Not at All Important decreased 3% and

# Before coming to NA were you...?




Employed increased 2%; Residence increased 3%;

# Areas of Improvement after coming to NA



Stable Housing decreased 4%; Employment decreased 4%; Education decreased 5% (without Iran decreased 1%); Family Relationships decreased 2%; and Hobbies decreased 3% (without Iran stayed the same).


# Currently Taking Prescribed Medications

No decreased 2%.


Without Iran,

# Reasons for Medication



Mental Health increased 8%; Chronic Health decreased 2%; Drug Replacement increased 2%; and Maintenance increased 5%. 49% (14,056 of 28,631) responded to the question in 2024, 44% (12,336 of 28,495) responded to the question in 2018.


# Country of Residence



USA decreased 12%
