We have great news today, so we'll just get to it: **WCNA 39 will be in Dublin, Ireland!** For months we have been in dialogue with several cities in Europe, considering various locations to celebrate NA's 75th anniversary. There were strong arguments for several cities, which is one reason it took so long to reach a decision. We are particularly grateful to the members who invested so much heart in the process. Dates are still under discussion but in all likelihood the convention will be in July 2028. Start making your plans. We'll see you on the Emerald Isle!

The third and final piece of the new H&I Basics revision is [up for Fellowship review](#). Over the course of this cycle, in response to a motion at the 2023 WSC, we have revised H&I Basics to create a three-part resource, including one for Corrections and one for Treatment. This last piece contains information for and about local H&I Committees and is available for review for 90 days. At the end of

the 90-day review period, the draft will be revised based on your input and all three pieces will be made available as Service Material. Thanks for all your input so far. Fellowship participation always improves the work!
